

ITU TRIATHLON WORLD CUP 2011, "A RESOUNDING SUCCESS"

The International Triathlon Union (ITU) has lauded Auckland's planning and execution of the ITU Triathlon World Cup, held on 20th November 2011, which showcased a world class field of elite athletes competing. ITU technical delegate Thanos Nikopoulos praised the event, with triathlon's highlight World Cup Grand Final scheduled for Auckland in October 2012, "The most important thing is that we managed to test most of the operations we are going to have here next year. The Grand Final has a huge impact for New Zealand and Auckland has shown it can pull these events off with excellence."
